MISSION: Motivate middle school students living in Lorain's 231 Census tract to be engaged in learning & avoid risky behaviors through useful roles in the community - leading to success in work, college, and life.

WHY MIDDLE SCHOOL?

Healthier students are better learners,

- The middle school years are critical developmentally
- There is a correlation between positive engagement in these formative years and life success
- In South Lorain, only 6% of the adult population has a college or technical/skill degree or certificate, while 42.9% also live below the poverty line.
