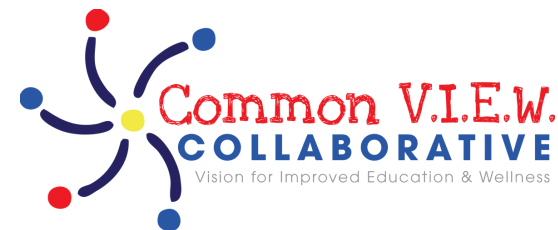

**MISSION:** Improve health knowledge, develop communication and life skills, and avoid of specific risk behaviors for middle school students. This work will support safe and positive social school environments.

### WHY MIDDLE SCHOOL?

**Healthier students are better learners,**

- The middle school years are critical developmentally
- There is a correlation between positive engagement in these formative years and life success
- In Clearview, Midview, and Firelands school districts, recent data show that 19% of students have considered suicide in the last year.
